

## SICOT-Congress-Scholarship 2026



From 29 September to 2 October 2026, the 46th SICOT Orthopaedic World Congress will take place in Kyoto, Japan. The German Section of SICOT e. V. awards a scholarship of €1,500 to support active participation in the congress. All information about the congress can be found at [www.sicot.org](http://www.sicot.org)

Eligible applicants are female and male physicians with an accepted abstract who are in specialist training (residency) in Orthopaedics and Trauma Surgery at a German hospital. Reimbursement will be made after completion of the trip upon submission of original receipts. Award recipients must be Associate Members of SICOT by the time of the congress. They are required to write a travel report and to present their experience at the annual meeting of the German Section of SICOT e. V., which will take place during the DKOU Congress 2026 in Berlin. At the same time, they will become members of the German Section of SICOT e. V.

Complete and meaningful application documents (curriculum vitae, list of publications, abstract, and a letter of recommendation from the head of the department) must be submitted by 1 May 2026 to the First Chair of the German Section of SICOT e. V.
